Principal's report: Lance Johnson- Principal

### 1. Building Update

- a. We met with Archie and Gord last week for the annual maintenance budget tour. Renovations in our school are on hold for the next while due to needs at other schools and a lack of a cabinet maker.
- b. The old primary playground and the inclusive swing will be installed in the spring with a rubberized surface. It will be located at the corner of Silver Star Road and East Vernon Road.
- c. Our counseling room will be renovated closer to summer.
- d. Our original primary classrooms will be renovated during the summer/fall.
- e. An inclusive door will be added to the GaGa Pit (no date given)
- f. Our extended learning center with three offices is complete and they are already being used. It's so nice for our students to have proper areas to work in with support people rather than an art storage area.

#### 2. Basketball

a. We are in full swing and our teams are practicing twice a week with league games being played on Wednesdays and Thursdays.

#### 3. Uniforms

- a. We are short uniforms. Currently, coaches take them home and wash them so another team can take them the next day to use for their game. Track and Field and Cross Country running use more jerseys than our team sports.
- b. We are hoping that our PAC can order more uniforms for our athletes to use.
- c. A new uniform costs about \$35 each based on a quote from the company that the school went with last time.

#### 4. Tube Town

Mrs. Van Dun is in the process of securing a date with Silver Star. The cost per student is looking to be about \$16 per student, unless pass for Silver Star. We'll try to figure out bussing costs through the school budget. It is my understanding that this was done in previous year. Do you have any worries or concerns about this field trip for our school?

-PAC members suggested that the younger grades go tubing for only 2 hours as in previous years they got tired. Silver Star has stipulated that only 200 can go up. Amanda C. suggested that the school go in 2 groups (am/pm) so that the whole school can still participate, and it keeps the length of time manageable for the primary grades. The PAC members believed that the \$16.00 cost was acceptable. This field trip is in the planning stages only.

#### **Kindergarten Registration**

a. We currently have 26 Kindergarten students registered and we're projected to have 52.

Motion made by Marnee M. to fund the new jerseys for the school. Seconded by Rachael M. Discussion held. **Motion carred.** 

The school will order approximately 50 jerseys at \$35.00 each and remit the invoice to the PAC for reimbursement from our gaming account.
